## **HEART TREATMENTS**

#### Interventional Procedures

- Angioplasty and Stenting: Opening blocked arteries with a balloon and placing a stent to keep them open.
- Cardiac Catheterization: A diagnostic procedure to examine how well the heart functions.
- Electrophysiology Studies (EPS): Testing the heart's electrical activity to diagnose arrhythmias.

### **Surgical Treatments**

- Coronary Artery Bypass Grafting (CABG): Surgery to improve blood flow to the heart by bypassing blocked arteries.
- **Heart Valve Surgery**: Repairing or replacing damaged heart valves.
- Pacemaker Implantation: A device implanted to regulate abnormal heart rhythms.

### Non-Invasive Diagnostic Testing Techniques

- Cardiac Rehabilitation: A structured program that includes exercise training, education, and counseling to improve heart health.
- **Echocardiography**: An ultrasound of the heart to assess its structure and function.
- **Holter Monitoring**: Continuous monitoring of heart rhythm for 24–48 hours to detect irregularities.
